## UC Research Repository update, April 2011

Unsurprisingly, the headline figures for the first quarter of 2011 are rather subdued. A quick glance at the tables below shows limited growth in all subject areas, although there have been several new additions from the College of Science and Civil Engineering, in particular, relating the seismic events in September and February. It was gratifying to see that some contributions were made in the second week after the February 22<sup>nd</sup> earthquake, despite the lack of access most of us had to our normal spaces and places. Visits to new researchers have also been temporarily postponed, but will hopefully resume one accommodation constraints ease.

Notable developments during the first quarter of this year include the ever changing copyright environment for institutional repositories, and our recent membership of CAIRSS (the Council of Australian University Libraries Australasian Institutional Repository Support Service). One of the responsibilities undertaken by the Repository staff is to check the copyright status for all material deposited in the Repository. Copyright transfer agreements have steadily been relaxed by publishers to allow institutions to make their research freely available. However, some publishers, most notably the IEEE, have tightened their policies, and their authors' rights have been curtailed slightly. The Repository staff actively monitor the copyright environment, in order to ensure that material is made freely available, without impacting on the crucial relationship between researchers and publishers. CAIRSS is a resource that allows us to tap into a great wealth of information regarding copyright, technical infrastructure and repository best practice. It is interesting to note that most Australian institutional repositories are now taking an active role in dataset curation, with support from the Federal Government.

As always, we invite new and established researchers to deposit their work with us. The UC Research Repository is fully compliant with publisher copyright, and we are happy to provide training and advice to individuals or groups. If you'd like more information on any aspect of the Repository, and how it works, contact the Repository Coordinator (grant.barrie@canterbury.ac.nz). Researchers can also get individual assistance from their department's Information Librarian.
