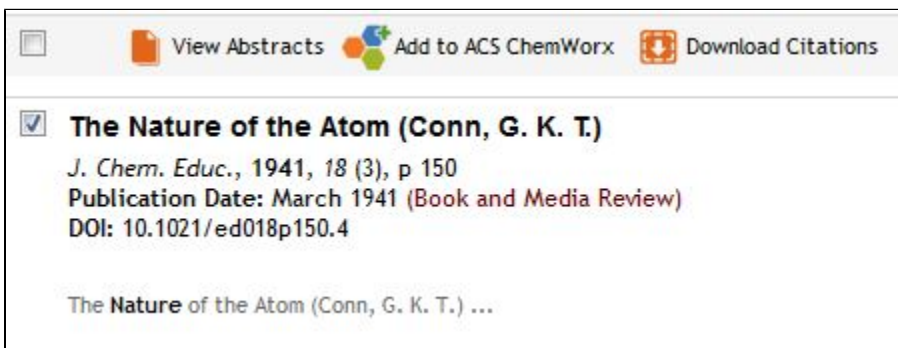


# Downloading records from American Chemical Society

You can export references directly into EndNote.

1. Select the results you want to keep, then click **Download Citations**.



2. Select Format: **RIS — For EndNote, ProCite, RefWorks, and most other reference management software**, and click **Download Citation(s)**.
