## **Downloading records from Agricola**

You can connect to Agricola from within EndNote and download references directly.

Start EndNote and go to Tools -> Online Search , or click on Online Search icon
In Choose a Connection window choose National Agricultural Library.

1. Mark the records you want to keep and then at the bottom of the page choose Export Format and then click on Format for Print or Save.
